Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, people of all ages throughout the world have developed illnesses from Toxic Injury; and

WHEREAS, Toxic Injury is often characterized by heightened sensitivity to very small amounts of air pollution, petrochemicals and other toxins found in our everyday products and environment; and

WHEREAS, Toxic Injury may include multiple, often disabling illnesses and can be life threatening; and

WHEREAS, Toxic Injury is a chronic debilitating condition for which there is no known cure, causing serious financial, employment, learning, housing, health, and social consequences; and

WHEREAS, the prevalence of these illnesses and the lack of knowledge and qualified doctors clearly warrant further education in this field for the public in general and for professionals who deal with these toxic substances; and

WHEREAS, those suffering with Toxic Injury deserve the same support and help allotted to those with any other illnesses or disabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 2008 as

TOXIC INJURY AWARENESS AND EDUCATION MONTH

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
