



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, molds are ubiquitous in nature, and mold spores are a common component of household and workplace dust, but when mold spores are present in large quantities, they can present a health hazard to humans, potentially causing allergic reactions and respiratory problems; and

WHEREAS, mold allergy has become a serious problem for many people; and

WHEREAS, health problems associated high levels of airborne mold spores include allergic reactions, asthma episodes, irritations of the eye, nose and throat, infections, sinus congestion, and other respiratory problems; and

WHEREAS, the number of toxic mold cases is rising dramatically, mostly due to the growing knowledge of the dangers of toxic mold; still, toxic mold is still vastly unknown about by the medical community and the general population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM GIBBONS, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim September 21-27, 2008, as
